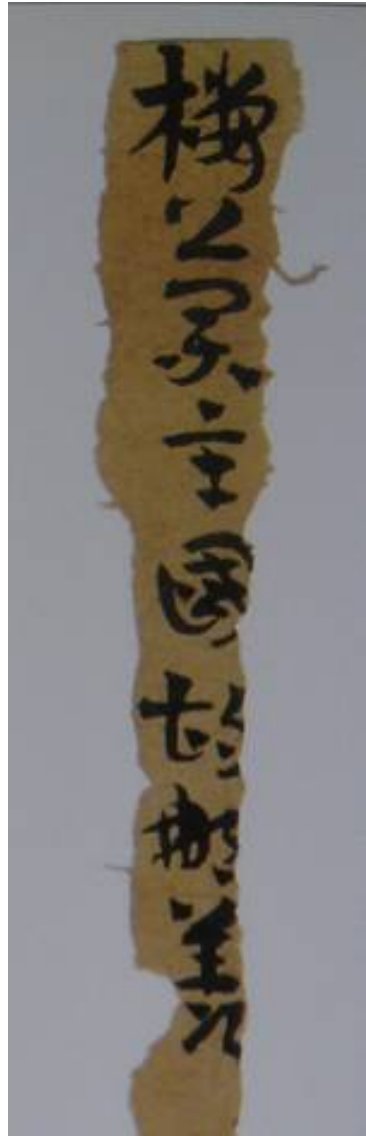

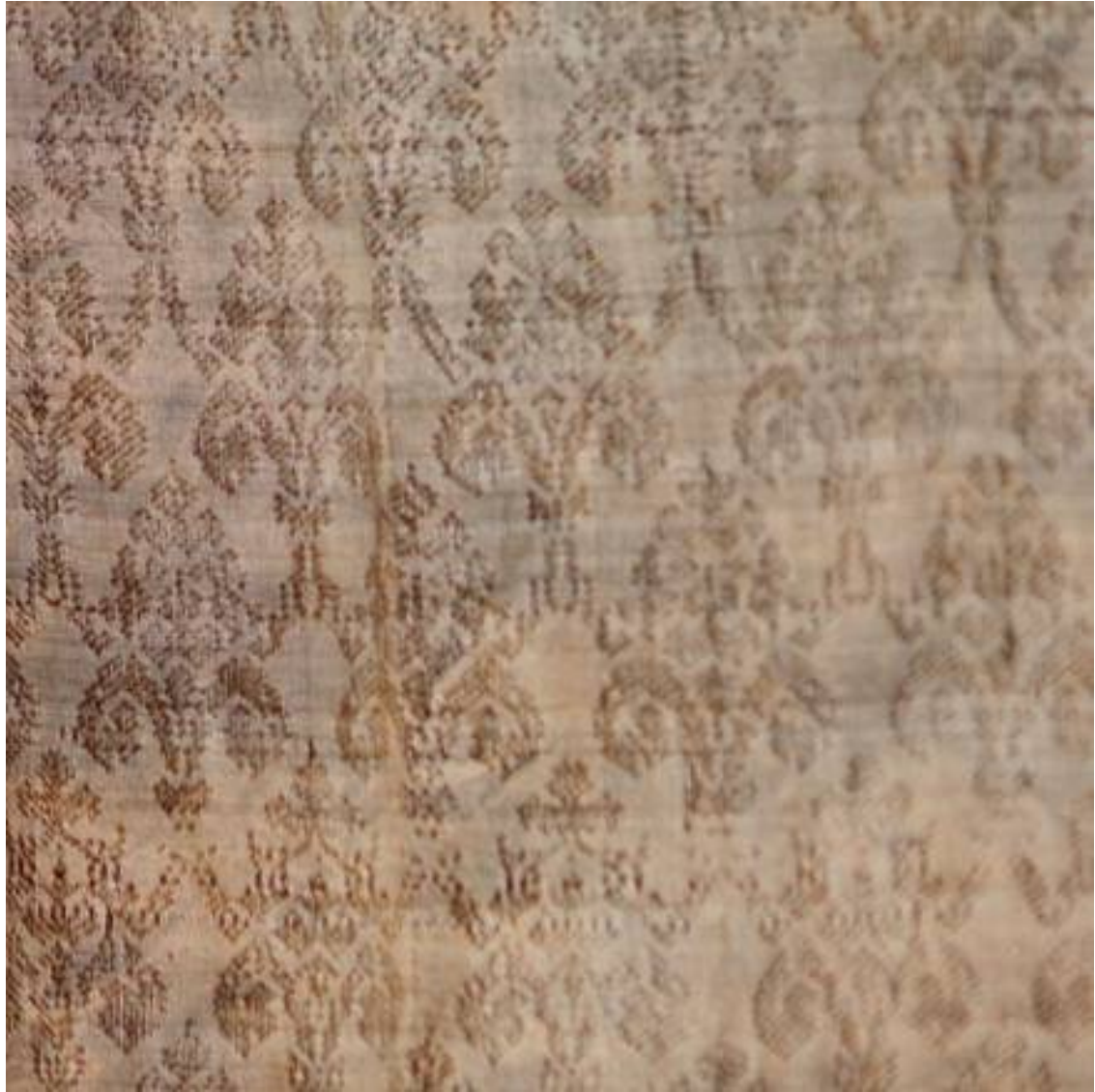

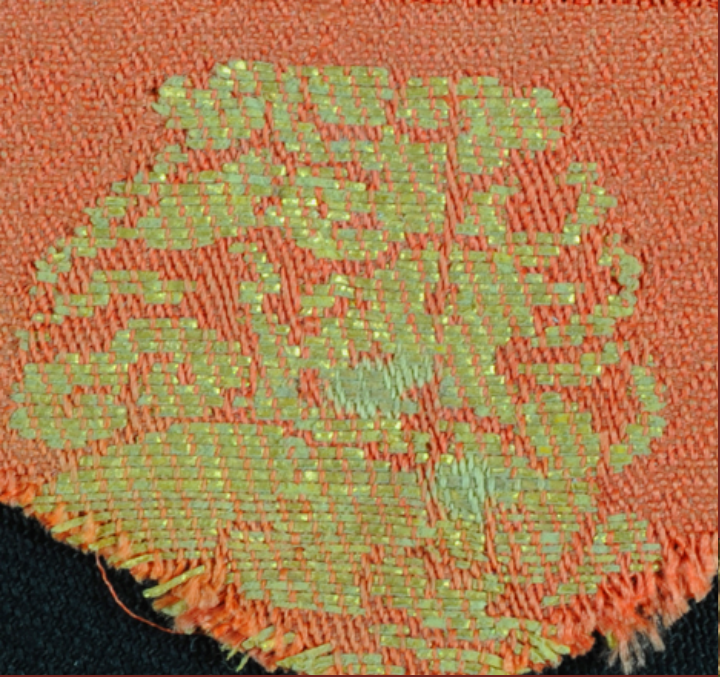


Liao samite, compound twill weft faced on both sides

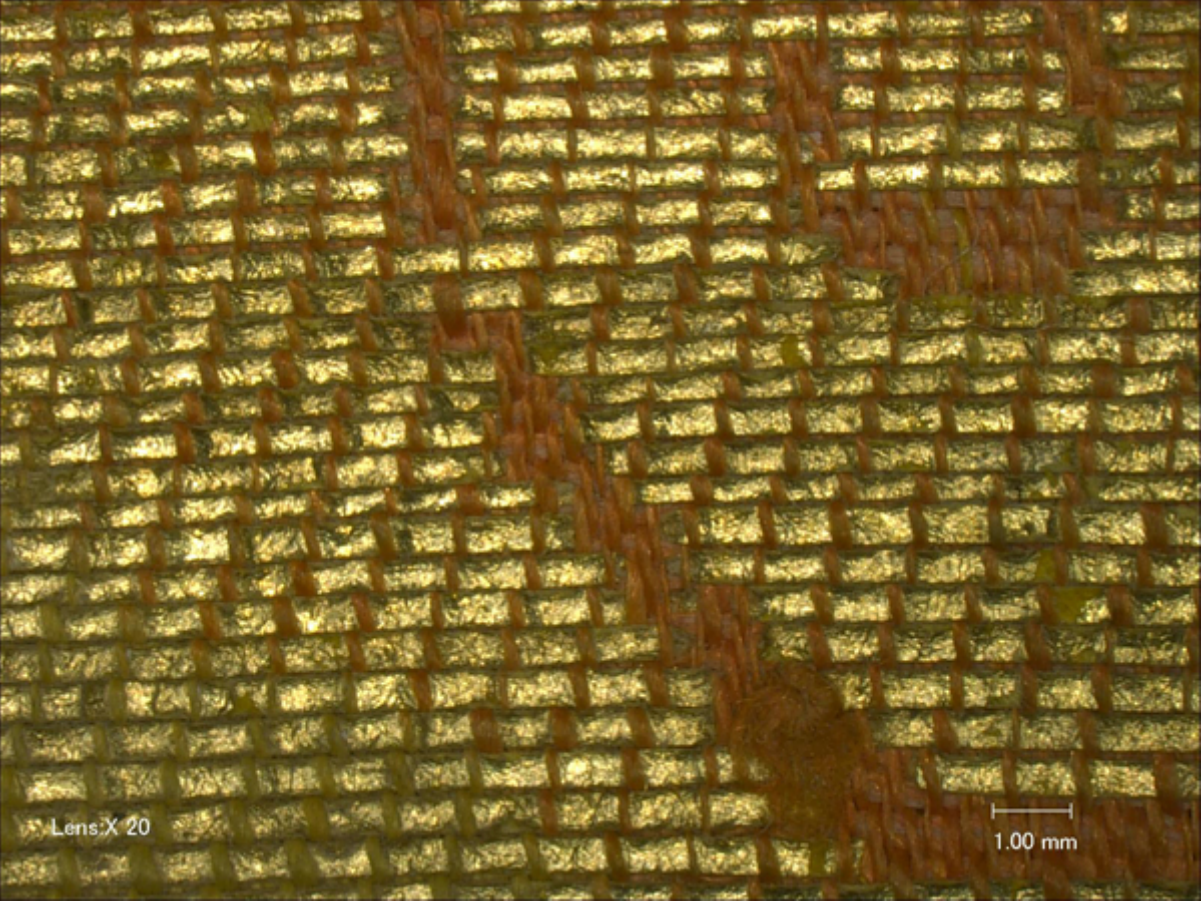

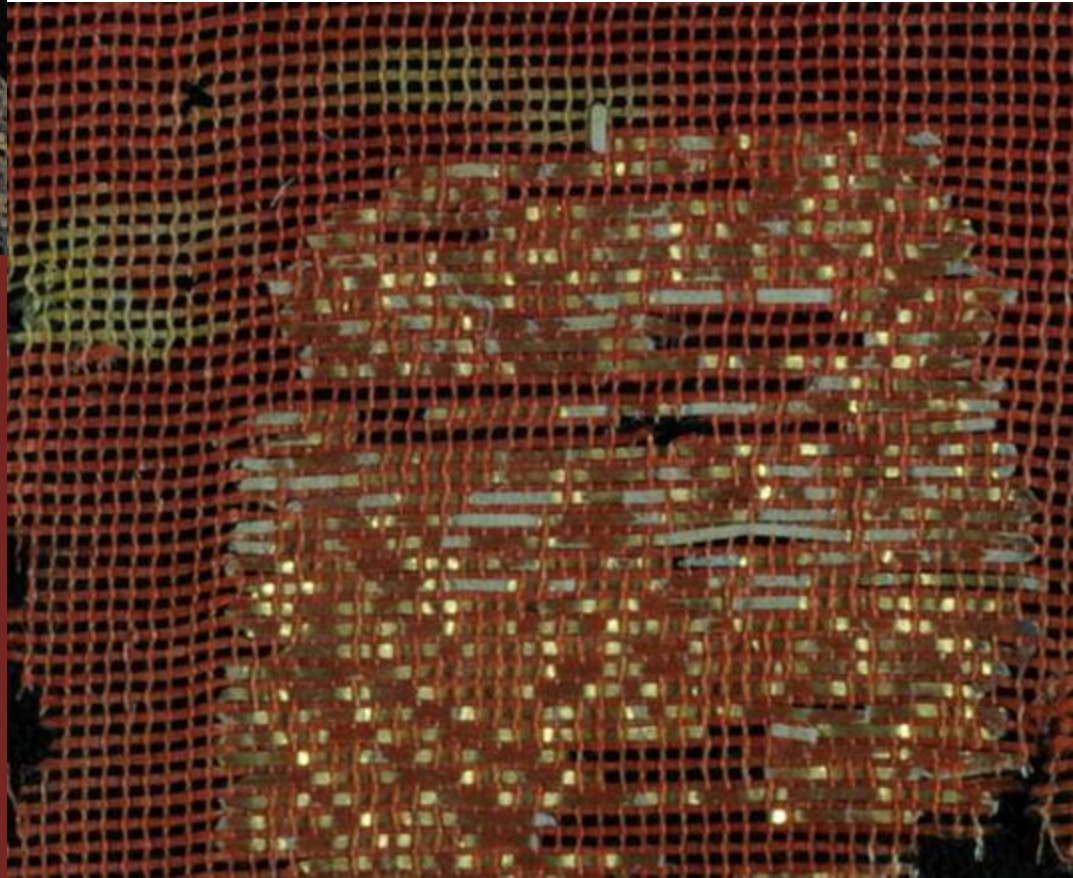
